Key Differences with Previous Reporting

HFA

- Reporting heavily reliant on country reporting capacity
- Mostly Qualitative
- Reporting every two years
- No coherence with MDG reporting
- Self-assessed ratings

Sendai

- Blend of Quantitative and Qualitative
- Coherence with SDG reporting
- Minor reporting each year (for SDGs) plus
Major reporting once every two years (Sendai cycle)
- Partner input options for reporting (Country Contributors)

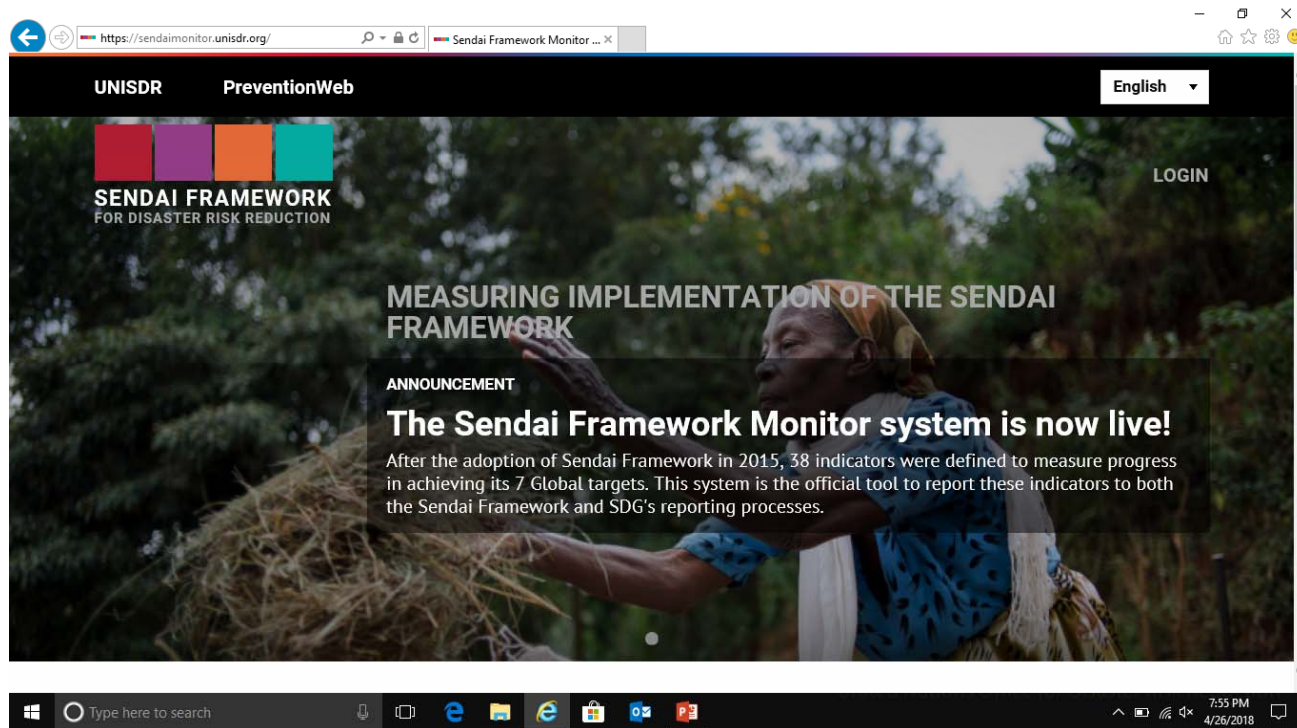

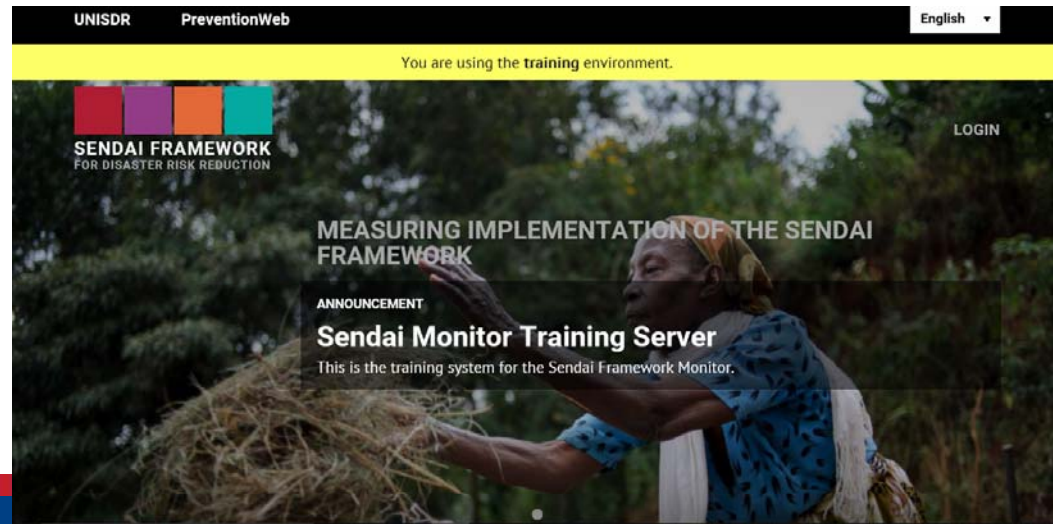
