DM Framework at National Level



Ministries and Departments of Gol

- Take measures for prevention of disasters, mitigation, preparedness and capacity building
- Integrate measures for prevention or mitigation of disasters into their development plans and projects
- Prepare DM Plan and update annually
- Allocate funds for undertaking activities under its DM Plan

- Community training in peace time.


